Welcome to the 2009 National Camp School at Rome, GA.

Your application has been received and on behalf of the camp school faculty, we eagerly look forward to having you with us at Camp Sidney Dew. The Administrative Director for this camp school will be Rob Stone. **You can review pertinent material relating to your Section by going to the Camping Section of the Southern Region web site (www.srbsa.org).**

A CLASS 3 medical examination and health record, completed within the past 12 months, are required and must be completed prior to your arrival. Please bring the completed form with you. If you do not have this required form, you will be transported to the nearest community for a physical examination at a cost of \$100.

Plan to arrive by 10:00 a.m. (EST) on Saturday, May 9, 2009. Departure will be after breakfast on Friday, May 15, 2009. *All participants who are enrolled in any retraining sections will be able to depart after Noon on Tuesday, May 12, 2009.* A reminder – **complete, correct BSA uniforms are required.** The BSA Field Uniform (Scout shorts or long trousers, Scout shirts, Venturing shirts, Scout socks) or the BSA Activity Uniform (Scout shorts or pants with Scouting golf or t-shirts) will be worn at camp school. Complete field uniform is required for evening meals, worship services, campfires, and other formal activities. (See attached Uniform Inspection Sheet.) Housing will be tents with cots. **Bedding and linens will not be provided.** The telephone number at Camp Sidney Dew is 706-234-2393 in case of emergency.

In addition to the items listed above, please bring an open mind, a cooperative attitude, a willing smile, a lot of enthusiasm, and we'll have a great course.

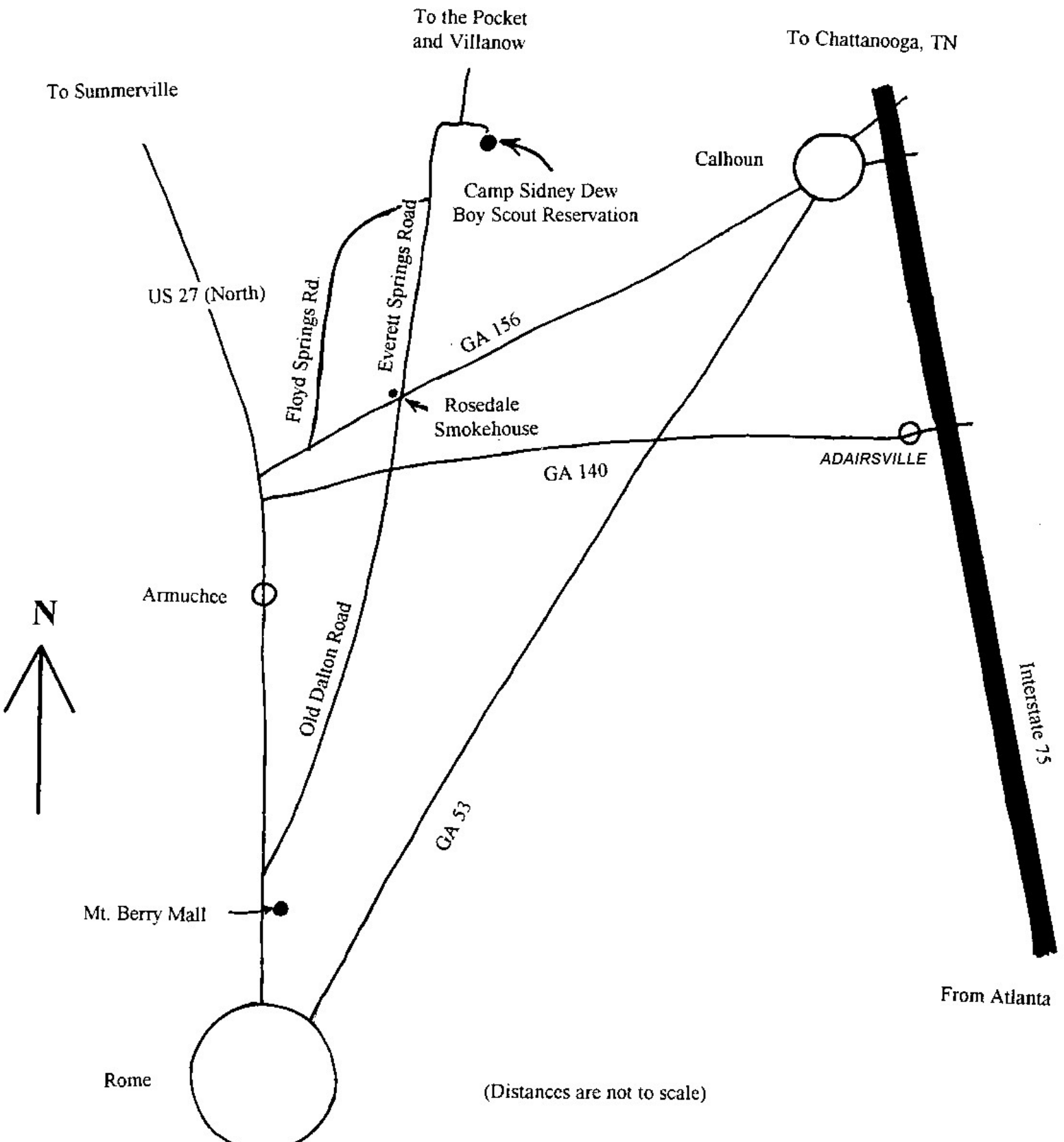
If you need to arrive at camp school early, you may come on Friday night. The early arrival fee is \$20, which includes breakfast on Saturday. Please return the attached form with your payment to the regional office if you plan to arrive early.

Unfortunately, there are no provisions for ground transportation from the airport. If you plan to travel by air to camp, you need to fly into the Atlanta Airport and rent a car to drive to camp, allowing at least one hour and ½ hour to drive to camp from the airport.
